

HOW TO USE THE SORBUS INTERNATIONAL BIOSECURITY FULL KIT

1. SETUP:

- **Select a suitable location:** Choose a well-ventilated space, preferably outdoors or in an area where any spills or runoff can be easily managed.
- **Unpack the Kit:** Remove all items from the storage holdall and lay them out for easy access.

2. PRELIMINARY CLEANING:

- **Boot Scraper:** Use the boot scraper to remove any large pieces of debris, mud, or dirt from your footwear.
- **Hard Brush:** For stubborn or dried-on debris, use the hard brush to scrub and remove any contaminants.

3. DEEP CLEANING:

- **Fill Water Container:** Use the collapsible water container to hold fresh water for rinsing.
- **Long Handle Brush:** Dip the long handle brush into the water and scrub the surfaces of your tools or equipment. The long handle is especially useful for reaching harder-to-access places or for tools with longer shafts.

4. PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT (PPE):

- **Chemical Protective Gloves:** Always wear these gloves when handling disinfectants or when deep cleaning to protect your hands from chemicals and contaminants.
- **Chemical Goggles:** Wear these goggles to protect your eyes, especially when using sanitising agents or when there's a risk of splashback.

5. DISINFECTION:

- **CleanKill Sanitiser:** This sanitiser is ready to use and does not require dilution. It's best suited for tyres and boot soles. Spray CleanKill directly onto the tyres or boot soles you intend to disinfect. See safety data sheet for further information.
- **Propellar Sanitiser:** This sanitiser is also ready to use and is best suited for metal items like handsaws. Spray Propellar directly onto the metal tools you want to disinfect. See safety data sheet for further information.
- If you have the portable pressure washer as an extra, use this for a thorough rinse after sanitising.

6. WASTE MANAGEMENT:

- **Disposable Biohazard Bags:** Use these bags to dispose of any contaminated materials, debris, or protective equipment you might want to discard after cleaning. Ensure the bags are sealed properly before disposing of them according to local guidelines.

7. STORAGE:

- **Collapsible Water Container & Flexible Bucket:** Empty, clean, and dry these containers before storing.
- **Place All Items in the Storage Holdall:** Once everything is dry and clean, repack all items into the holdall to keep them organised and ready for the next use.

8. OPTIONAL EXTRAS:

- **Hermetically Sealed Containers:** If using these containers, ensure that they are properly sealed after storing any sanitising solutions or other liquids to prevent spills or contamination.

Always ensure you are working in a clean environment and store all equipment properly to ensure they're ready for the next use.
